Use passwords and instructions provided to access TGS Teen PSA Resources. Teen PSAs are fully downloadable and easily shared with your students via Google Classroom, email, social media or other methods. Videos are copyrighted and editing is not permitted.

Ideas for using Teen PSAs:

- Advisory/character development time
- Used in conjunction with awareness campaigns (suicide prevention month, anti-bullying week, prom, etc.)
- Health classes
- Creative writing prompts and topic essays
- Counselor/SRO topic discussions
- Alternative School and ISS required viewing, individual and group disciplinary intervention
- Math bell ringer problems (using statistics found in PSAs)
- Career prep classes, life skills instruction
- Multimedia design, video production classes (Video production students can also act as a resource in collaboration with other departments which is a great way to demonstrate the need for this arts elective.)
- EL classes and ESL classes
- Criminal justice classes
- AP Psychology classes
- Capstone projects
- Drivers ed classes
- Journalism classes
- Student government
- Peer mentor programs
- Theatre department, debate team
- Clubs (Key Club, Civitans, SADD, etc.)
- School social workers' use, school health and safety team use
- Closed circuit video loop broadcasts during lunchtime
- School video announcement broadcasts
- Community service component (Have your high school students schedule talks with middle schoolers to share and discuss appropriate TGS Teen PSAs, including those created by your high school students.)
- Share TGS Teen PSA Best of the Best Resource and password with feeder school administrators and counselors
- Faculty meetings/professional development
- Use of Teen PSA Program helps teachers elevate their teaching from levels 1's and 2's to 3's and 4's
